There is a possibility the City will decide to defer the project for several months as it has deferred many other projects, but I'm hoping that because we've gone through such an extensive public process to get to this point we'll get the green light to proceed. As soon as we have that green light I'll start working with the committee to set a date for the community meeting with Bruce and we'll be on our way.
