

1. The meeting was called to order by President Michelle Hilhorst.
2. President's Report, Michelle Hilhorst.
 - a. Weekend planting project. This was well attended and the task only took 90 minutes to complete.
 - b. Candidate forum. NHCC hosted this forum for the candidates running in the 41st District.
 - c. Repaving update. The neighbors affected by the parking areas converted to bike lane are in contact with the City of Bellevue for resolution.

Article IV, Section 5. Trustees shall serve their respective Areas by attending General Membership meetings at least once per quarter, serve as a conduit of information from the Board of Directors to their assigned area and vice versa.

Using the Board-approved template, trustees may collect email addresses and phone numbers of residents in their area and other NH residents known to the Trustee. This information will be used to keep the neighbors informed on issues of concern to the community and to encourage membership.

Motion made, seconded and carried to accept these changes to the Trustee description as presented. Motion made, seconded and carried to change the term of the Trustee from two to one year.
