

- A. Speakers: Brian Teppner, incoming Newport Heights Elementary School principal and Jack McLeod, BSD Facilities Director who addressed future plans for the Lake Heights YMCA building. Brian introduced himself and provided his bio then opened the floor up for questions. Jack was asked about installing synthetic turf for NH Elementary. It's coming but he does not know when. He reported that the demographics of Bellevue are changing as more senior residents are selling homes to young families, so the demand for schools is high. The YMCA organization will leave by the end of the year. Starting in January 2015, the building will be remodeled and brought up to code. It is estimated to cost \$4M million. It will then house the Chinese immersion program - Jing Mei - starting in August 2015.
