

PONCHO is a non-profit corporation dedicated to helping support the civic, cultural and charitable activities of the Seattle area, with primary emphasis on those of a cultural nature. Each year, PONCHO conducts a giant auction, with proceeds going to previously designated organizations. What is PONCHO?

During the past two auctions, PONCHO has raised a total of \$245,000 for local organizations. Major beneficiaries have included the Seattle Art Museum and a special Opera Fund. Additional gifts have gone to the Seattle Repertory Theatre, Lighthouse for the Blind, Seattle Hearing & Speech Center, Cornish School (Music Division), New Dimensions in Music, Kirkland Creative Arts League, Council on Aging and the Seattle Chorale.




